RCIA

As we approach the month of September and thoughts turn to children returning to school, it is also time to consider our RCIA and Adult Confirmation classes. This year we will be incorporating a program called FORMED offered by the Augustine Institute. This is an on-line program that can be used by all parishioners. Specific curricula will be developed for the RCIA and Adult Confirmation classes. More information about this program will be forthcoming.

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is for those baptized in the Catholic Church and never pursued any other sacraments or those baptized in another Christian denomination who seek communion in the Catholic Church. We will also be offering an Adult Confirmation class for those 18 and older who have received the sacraments of baptism, penance, and first communion but have not been confirmed. 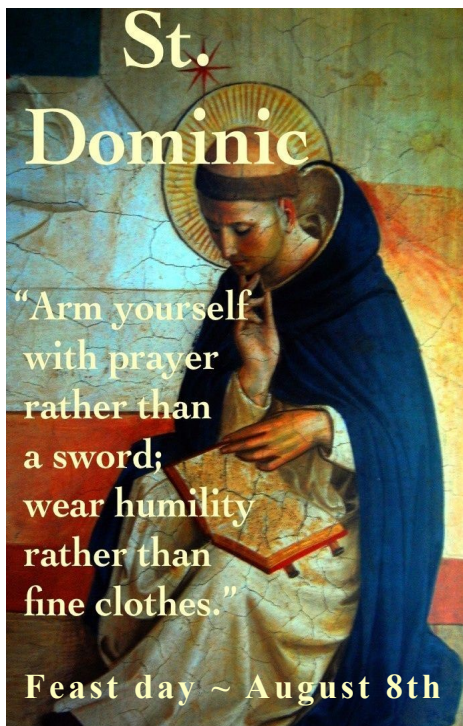
