Specific curricula will be developed for the RCIA and Adult Confirmation classes. More information about this program will be forthcoming. The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is for those baptized in the Catholic Church and never pursued any other sacraments or those baptized in another Christian denomination who seek communion in the Catholic Church. We will also be offering an Adult Confirmation class for those 18 and older who have received the sacraments of baptism, penance, and first communion but have not been confirmed.

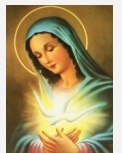
