## Daly Note's

---

**Saint Francis de Sales, said, "Every one of us needs half an hour of prayer a day, except when we are busy - then we need an hour."** It is when we are anxious and worried about many things that we need prayer to remind us why we are so busy in the first place. Prayer helps us focus on Jesus. It calms our spirits and revives our energy. However, prayer seems to be the first thing we stop doing when we are busy. We cannot let that happen. Jesus tells us that listening to Him is the "better part." So we should make it the better part of our day every day, but especially if we are feeling overwhelmed.

Jesus' words to Martha are important for another reason. Too often, we believers can sometimes make our Christianity just about one thing. For instance, people who serve in soup kitchens can sometimes think that it is all about serving the poor and that, if you are not serving the poor, you are not a good Christian. Other people make Christianity just about going to Mass and prayer. To them, if your day isn't filled with rosaries, Divine Mercy chaplets, and other devotions, then you are not a good Christian.

If we are paying attention to Jesus, then we understand that following Him means doing all those things. It means serving the poor AND praying. It means going to Mass AND going to the soup kitchen. It is about working against abortion AND working against the death penalty. **There are many ways to follow Jesus. All of them are important.**

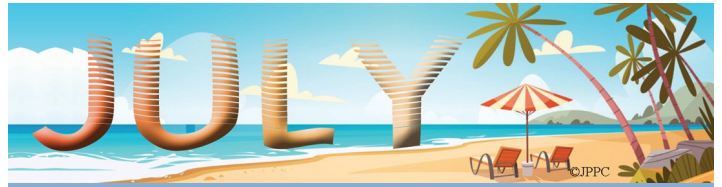
