This year we will celebrate a Mass of Remembrance on Wednesday, November 9, 2021 at 7:00 pm at Holy Spirit Church. During this special Mass, following the homily, we will be reading the names of those whose funeral Mass was celebrated at Annunciation Parish since November 1, 2021.

All are welcome to attend, and families and friends of the deceased are encouraged to join us in this special All Souls Mass. It is our prayer that this Mass of Remembrance will bring you peace of heart as we honor your loved one.

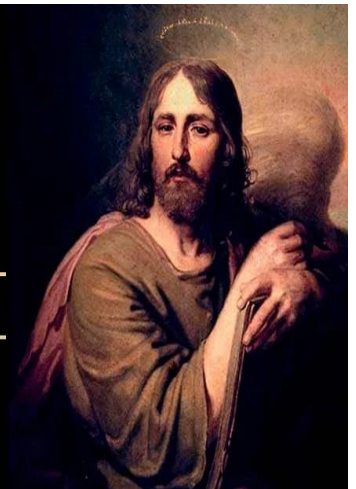
### The Annunciation Women's Guild

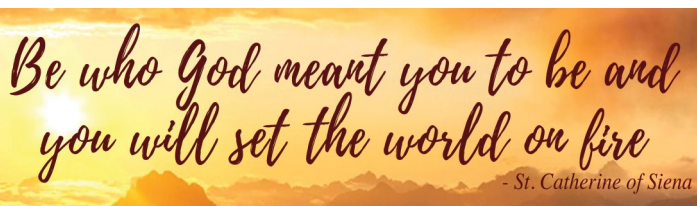
