Daly Note's

A saint is simply a sinner who has experienced God's mercy. That encounter with God's love and forgiveness is so life changing that the saint then goes on to share it with others.

In our second reading today, Paul tells us, "I was once a blasphemer and a persecutor and arrogant, but I have been mercifully treated." This experience gave Saint Paul the passion to proclaim the forgiveness of sins to others.

We are no different from Saint Paul. We are all sinners to whom God offers forgiveness and mercy. No matter how we may have offended God, we can all return home by going to confession. In that great sacrament, we experience God's mercy for ourselves. It is that love and mercy that will heal us. We welcome it into our hearts and allow it to heal us.

God is calling all of to be saints, that is, to become friends of God and imitators of Christ. It starts with me and it starts with you.

We would do well to pray today for the grace to follow God's call to us to be saints. It is never too late.

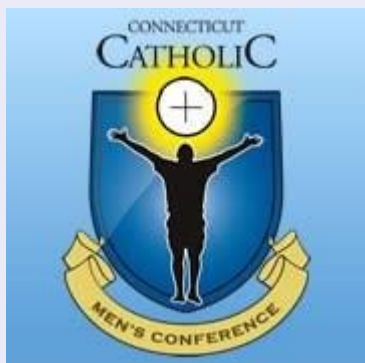
Religious Education

Have you ever wondered what the Annunciation Women's Guild is all about? Now is your chance to find out! The Annunciation Women's Guild will hold their first meeting of the 2022-2023 year on Tuesday, September 13th, at 6:30 PM in the Holy Spirit Church hall. The Women's Guild general membership meetings are held once a month on a Tuesday from September through May (except for January). We usually have speakers or entertainment following our business portion of each meeting. Our program in September will be a presentation about the actress Doris Day by Patty Carver from New York.

We also hold a Christmas Party and end of year Banquet (when transitioning new board members). We have a few parish fundraisers each year (Tag Sale, Mother's Day Plant Sale, Bake Sale, Saint Patrick's Day meal, etc) and assist when requested with our parish celebrations and activities. The Guild activities and fundraisers allow us to provide financial support to our parish and other community charities and groups. Recently the Guild has been able to donate a total of \$8,000 including financial donations for some parish repairs, gift cards for parishioners in need, and donations to several non profit organizations including: Newington Social Services, Ukrainian Solidarity Fund, Prudence Crandall Center, South Park Inn, Friendship Center, Interco munity Rehab Center, and the Summer Got Lunch Program. New members are always welcome. The dues are only \$10 for the entire 2022-2023 year. You can place your envelope with payment in a collection basket at any Mass or bring it to the first meeting in September.
