# **General Guidelines for Wedding Music**

## Selections

- Liturgical and classical pieces are appropriate for the Catholic wedding ceremony. Popular or other types of music are not permitted within the mass.
- If vocal pieces are selected and you wish to have a friend or family member sing during the ceremony, please note that this vocalist must be available to meet with the Music Director sometime before the ceremony to rehearse the piece(s).

## Instrumentation

- The Music Director is an organist and pianist. You may select to have all of the music performed on one instrument or the other, or you may request a mix of both. If no specification is made, there will be a mix of both organ and piano.
- The Music Director is also a flautist. Solo flute is available upon request—ask the Music Director for more details and repertoire offerings. If you would like flute accompanied by piano or organ, the Music Director will attempt to locate another flautist or accompanist and will inform you of the added musician's fee.
- If another instrument is requested to play along with the organ, the Music Director will attempt to locate a musician for the ceremony and will inform you of the added musician's fee.

## MUSIC SELECTION FOR WEDDINGS

#### PRELUDE MUSIC

Please select your preferred instrumentation for prelude selections: organ, piano, flute, combination.

## PROCESSIONAL MUSIC

An instrumental piece is performed while the wedding party processes in (includes bride).

- Canon in D Pachelbel
- Bridal Chorus from *Lohengrin* Wagner

## **PIANO**

- Canon in D Pachelbel
- Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring J.S. Bach

## **RESPONSORIAL PSALM**

Select a psalm from the wedding preparation booklet "Together for Life." Decide if you would like the psalm to be read or sung. If sung, inform the Music Director of your psalm choice and she will locate a musical setting of it. There are organ/chant settings available for options C1-6 and contemporary piano settings available for options C2, C3, and C6.

## PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS and COMMUNION

Please select <u>TWO</u> vocal or instrumental pieces, one for each part of the mass. (For a wedding with no mass, please select <u>ONE</u> piece as a meditation.)

An instrumental piece is performed while the wedding party processes out.

## **POSTLUDE**

Please select your preferred instrumentation for the postlude selection: organ, piano, flute. Often the postlude will be performed on the same instrument as the recessional, but that is not necessary.
