<u>Saints of the Week ~ July 29th</u> The Feast of Martha, Mary and Lazarus

The Gospel stories of Martha, Mary and Lazarus offer moving portraits of two sisters and a brother, blessed to be good friends of Jesus, who often visited their home in Bethany. Because of their witness "in welcoming the Lord Jesus into their home," last year Pope Francis added the Memorial of Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus to the Church's liturgical calendar on July 29th. The Holy Father established the memorial because of "the important evangelical witness they offered in welcoming the Lord Jesus into their home, in listening to him attentively, in believing that he is the resurrection and the life."

A decree issued February 2, 2021, by the Congregation for Divine Worship, said: "In the household of Bethany, the Lord Jesus experienced the family spirit and friendship of Martha, Mary and Lazarus, and for this reason the Gospel of John states that He loved them. Martha generously offered Him hospitality, Mary listened attentively to His words, and Lazarus promptly emerged from the tomb at the command of the One who humiliated death."
