



Deacon Jim Tanguay

If you really think about our lives, it's all about decisions, isn't it? Some of those decisions are small, such as what to have for dinner. Others can be life changing, like - *should I go to college*? For Christians, we must ask *how decisive am I in following Jesus*? That's the big question - not only today, but in each and every day of our lives. The readings today present us with the reality of decisions; we are called by God to be decisive. But while we want to be decisive and have the freedom to make our own decisions, decisions bring with them consequences.

In the first reading we find the need for security being challenged by the decision to move into an unknown future. In the second reading we're presented with a false freedom, the freedom of license and anything goes vs. the true freedom of loving for the sake of others, particularly the Other that is God. Finally, in the Gospel we find the challenge to move beyond the ties of family loyalty and affection, into commitments beyond the pale of one's immediate family, movement into the decisions and responses that go with belonging to God.

Let us choose God with the same responsible abandon of Elisha following Elijah, the same true freedom mentioned by Paul, and the same firm resolve of Jesus going to Jerusalem. Let each of us discern the Jerusalem we must face in our lives – whether it be someone we dislike, or a relative with whom we are on the outs, or a duty we have been avoiding. That kind of commitment and effort frees us from the game people play, from the rat race, from peer pressure. It makes us free to be different without being afraid. It is exhilarating, and filled with joy.
