

# PLEASE WELCOME ST. MARY'S NEW MUSIC DIRECTOR, MARK NEUMANN STARTING ON MARCH 12TH

From early childhood Mark loved music an singing. His parents listened to music all the time. His father especially loved to listen to organ recordings, thus, stimulating Mark's interest in the organ.

Mark began singing in his churches youth choir, and through the years, moved all the way to the adult choir and eventually the director. He began organ lessons at age 11. Entering High School, intent in going on and studying medicine, he met his dynamic choral director who pointed at him and said: "You will study voice and become a music teacher". The rest is history.

Mark studied at the then Hartt College of Music, and entered as a college student, where he completed his Bachelors Degree in Music Education and Voice in three and one half years. He began teaching Music in New Britain. He also continued at various churches as an organist and choir director. Mark then continued his education receiving two masters degrees in curriculum,

While in New Britain he moved from director of madrigal singing/show choir. Stage manager, department head, and eventually into administration. He served as district-wide Fine Arts Talented Facilitator. During this time he also directed Musicals and taught television production. For the past twelve years Mark has been the Director of Music and Organist at Most Holy Trinity Church in Wallingford. He has also performed solo vocally and instrumentaly in America and Europe. Mark was chosen to sing The National Anthem for President Ronald Reagan's visit to Connecticut. He continues to perform the Anthem for the New Britain Police Department Ceremonies.

Mark is fluent in German and has been able to serve as a tour leader Europe, Asia, and Africa. His hobbies include, of course travel, sky-diving, following the Boston Red Sox, The Boston Bruins. And the UCONN women's Basketball Team.
