Active Participation in the Parish and at Mass

There are many ministries in the parish that assist others either in prayer or in service, also known as "prayer in action." Since there is space in this bulletin, and a need in reality, it might be a good time to announce the opportunities for you to consider service in the parish as lectors, youth altar servers, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion and ushers. The Church envisions the lay faithful to take an active part in worship, primarily through proper attendance, paying attention, responding, singing, etc., but also through concrete acts of service as in the ministries mentioned above.

Lectors proclaim the word of God during Mass after praying with and reviewing the reading at home prior to the liturgy, youth altar servers assist the priest and the deacon in the celebration of the Mass and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion bring the Blessed Sacrament to the homebound and assist in its distribution during Mass. Ushers have the role of welcoming parishioners, taking care of problems during the liturgy and collecting the offering during Mass.

Organizational and training sessions are being planned for the various positions of service in the celebration of the Mass, so please consider these ministries and watch for a future notice to learn more about each of the ministries and their requirements.

THE ANNUNCIATION WOMEN'S GUILD

Annunciation Women's Guild is celebrating a birthday. It will be six years old. June 29, 2017 the merger of the two churches, St. Mary's and Holy Spirit into one parish, "Annunciation." The formation of the Women's Guild took place about a year after the merger of the two churches. The blending of these two active groups of women continued the goals of the original groups. The goals were and are, to unify the women of the parish through friendship, social, cultural and spiritual activities. The Annunciation Women's Guild provides financial support to our parish and to the community through fundraising events.

The Guild meets on the second Tuesday of the month at the Holy Spirit Hall from September through May. We do not meet in January because of weather. Like many groups during the pandemic, we did not meet from March of 2020 until September 2021. Our meetings include a brief business meeting followed with a presentation by a speaker. The programs have included comedy, musical, informational on health or current events followed by a social time for refreshments.

The Annunciation Women's Guild keeps active with fundraising. Some of the events have been a yearly Tag Sale, Bake Sales and the Mother's Day Plant Sale. These events have been successful because of the wonderful support of the Annunciation Parish members and Newington citizens. In the last few years we have been able to replace vestments for the priests at both churches, replacement of the Holy Spirit lighting in the church, replacement of vacuum cleaners, restoration of the kitchen at Holy Spirit Hall, purchased the Mass Booklets one year. In addition we have contributed to community organizations such as Newington Human Services, House of Bread, Intercommunity Health Organization, Got Lunch, Prudence Crandall and the Knights of Columbus Ukrainian Relief Fund. We have also purchased gift cards to be available those who may be in need.

We have been hosting events over the years. We hosted Father MacNeill's reception after his first Mass at St. Mary's. We often host farewell receptions for the clergy. More recently we have hosted the Anniversary Mass. We provide support to those whose family members have died. We arrange Masses for deceased members of the Guild and form an honor guard at a member's funeral Mass.

With the celebration of our birthday as an organization Michelle Malkauskus will be presiding over activities as the new president of the Guild. The membership and volunteer support has been commendable. Plan to join us in September for our first meeting.
