## Fr. Joe's Reflections ...

As we are aware, World Mission Sunday is observed today, October 23rd. "You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8). These words were spoken by the Risen Jesus to his disciples just before his Ascension into heaven. They are also the theme of the 2022 World Mission Day which, as always, reminds us that the Church is missionary by nature. All the followers of Christ, all Christians as individuals and communities are entrusted with this mission of sharing the good news with whole creation. In Mark 6:1-13, the evangelist tells the story of Jesus' commissioning of the twelve apostles to preach the "good news" of repentance, forgiveness of sins, liberation and salvation through Jesus.

When it comes to the kingdom of God, God is just selecting random people without any kind of qualification. That simply tells us that each and every one of us are good enough for God because He does not create junk. It is also important to know that we are not the one doing the work of evangelization. Holy Spirit is the primary agent of evangelization and we make ourselves available to the mighty hand of the Holy Spirit and He will make use of you in a new way. To me evangelization has two aspects: Helping people to encounter Christ who never had the opportunity to do so. And then, helping people who already know Christ, to take their relationship with Him to a new level, or deeper level. To me, that is where we need to start right now. Some data and statistics compel us for that action. The pew research shows that 30% of the Americans who are raised Catholic are still practicing their faith. When we say they are practicing their faith, attending Mass at least once a month. 38% of the Americans who were raised Catholic hold onto their catholic identity; but seldom or rarely attend Mass. 32% of the Americans who were raised Catholics no longer consider themselves as Catholics. 10% of all adult Americans are former Catholics. So the study says, we have a need for re-evangelization.

World Mission Sunday reaffirms our call to be missionaries by virtue of our baptism. And it provides an opportunity to support the life giving presence of the Church among the poor and marginalized. We are called to offer our prayers and financial help for the Church's missionary work in Asia, Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe. As Pope Francis insists, may this October be extra ordinary month of prayer and reflection on the mission.
